"I'm going to miss the friendships that have been established with many great men and families, but family comes first and if relocating will make it easier, then that's what I have to do." As a father of five boys, one positive aspect of the move is being closer to his two older sons, his daughter-in-law and his two grandchildren.

Kevin had two different and distinct careers before starting as Fraternal Counsellor in 2003. His initial career was in Municipal Recreation in Peterborough, Ontario for almost twenty years, and served as Director of Recreation for the City of Peterborough for 13 years. Then Kevin began a career in Junior Hockey as a Coach, Scout and General Manager. "I really enjoyed working in hockey but to be successful it takes you away from your family a lot. We had a young family at the time and it really was difficult for my wife, Annie. So, in 2001, we moved to Montreal, where Annie grew up. I was very fortunate to have the opportunity to meet Roland Larocque, and not long after, I started as Fraternal Counsellor".

One of his biggest disappointments about the move is leaving the Roland Larocque Agency of the Knights of Columbus Insurance. "Having the opportunity to work with Roland and his wife Johanne has been great. Roland has been extremely supportive. Through his support, we've been able to introduce new ideas, almost double the English membership, work with Knights of Columbus representatives to form many new Councils and foster a closer working relationship between us on the Insurance side and Council Executives."
